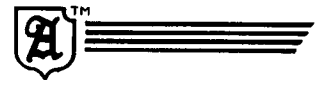




# ALMARK DECAL INSTRUCTION SHEET

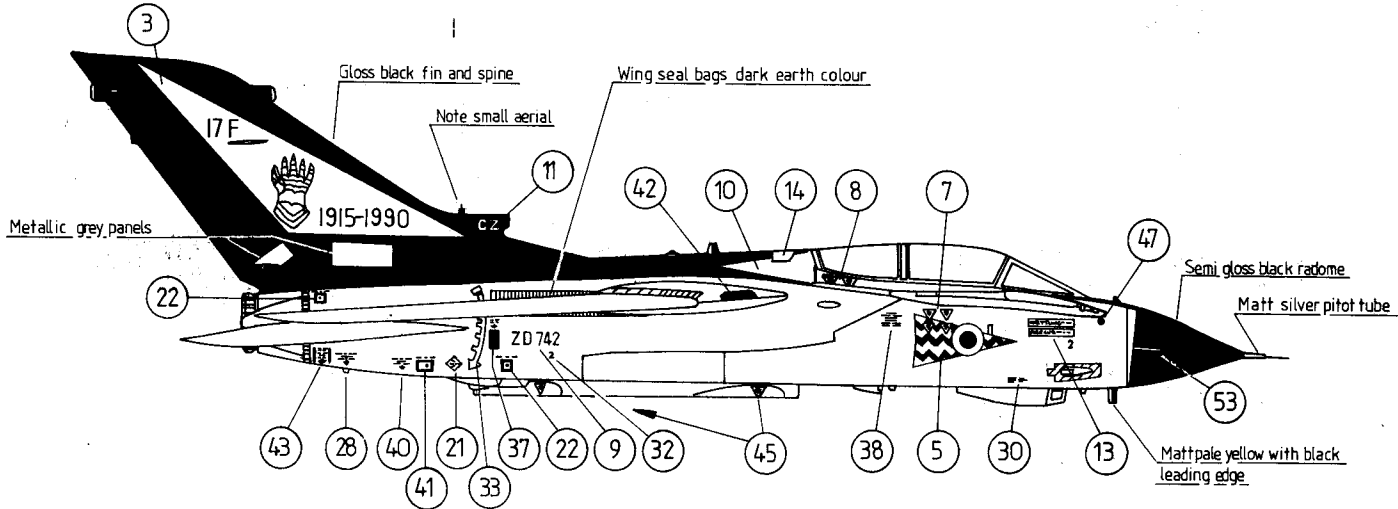
## 17(F) SQN RAFG 75TH ANNIVERSARY

1915 - 1990

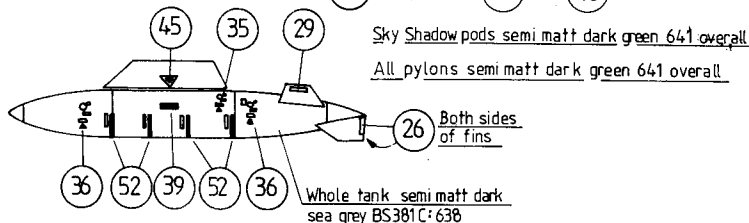
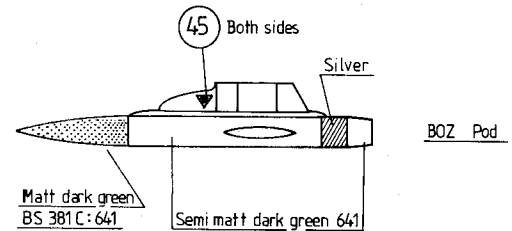
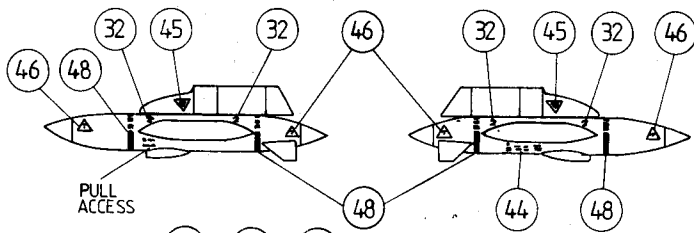
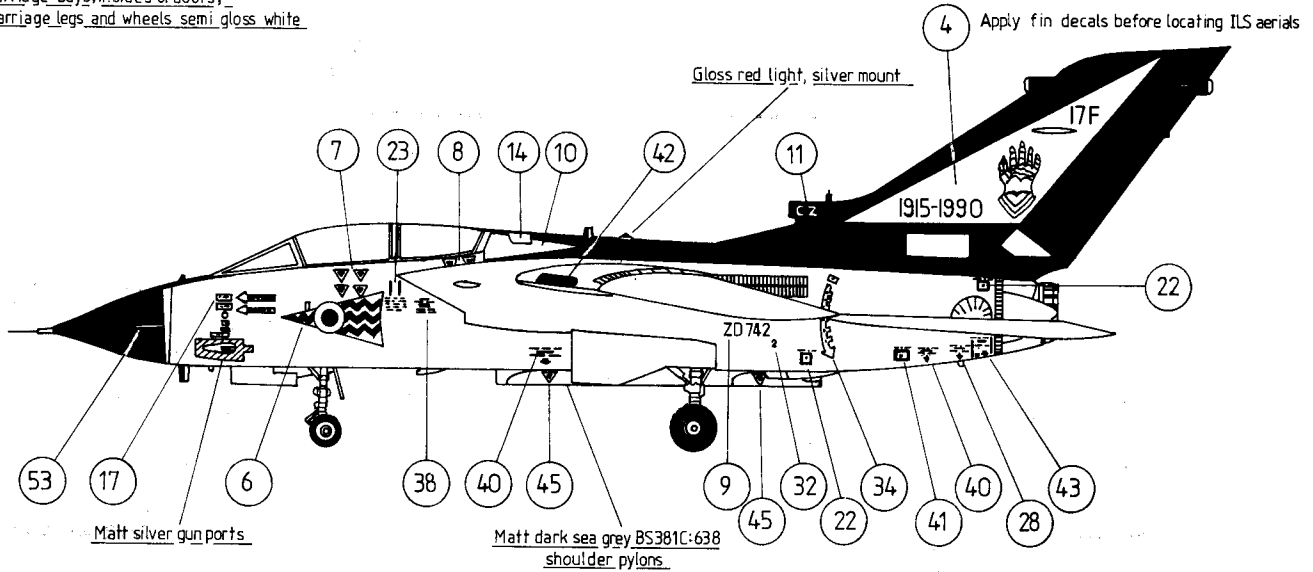


This decal sheet has been issued to commemorate the 75th anniversary of the forming of no. 17(F) Squadron of the Royal Air Force. It enables the modeller to construct a Panavia Tornado GR.1(T) ZD742 that was finished in a highly stylized scheme to celebrate the occasion, or alternatively, Tornado GR 1 ZD792 finished in standard camouflage scheme or with high viz tail as applied in March 1989 to try to minimize the risk of low level flying accidents. 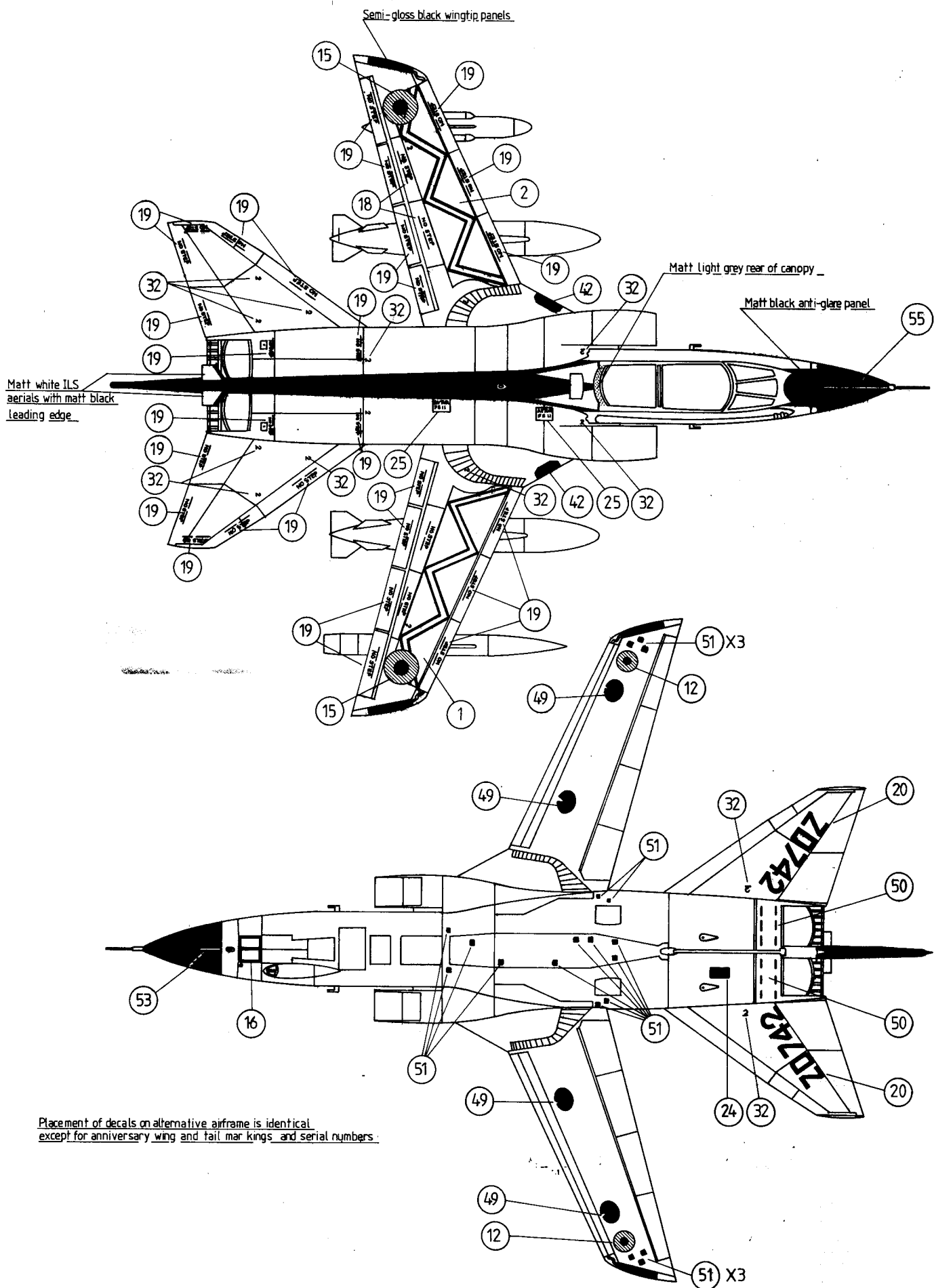
Camouflage schemes have been omitted from decal placement diagrams for clarity. They are illustrated separately.



Inside of air brakes, wheel wells, undercarriage bays, insides of doors, undercarriage legs and wheels semi gloss white

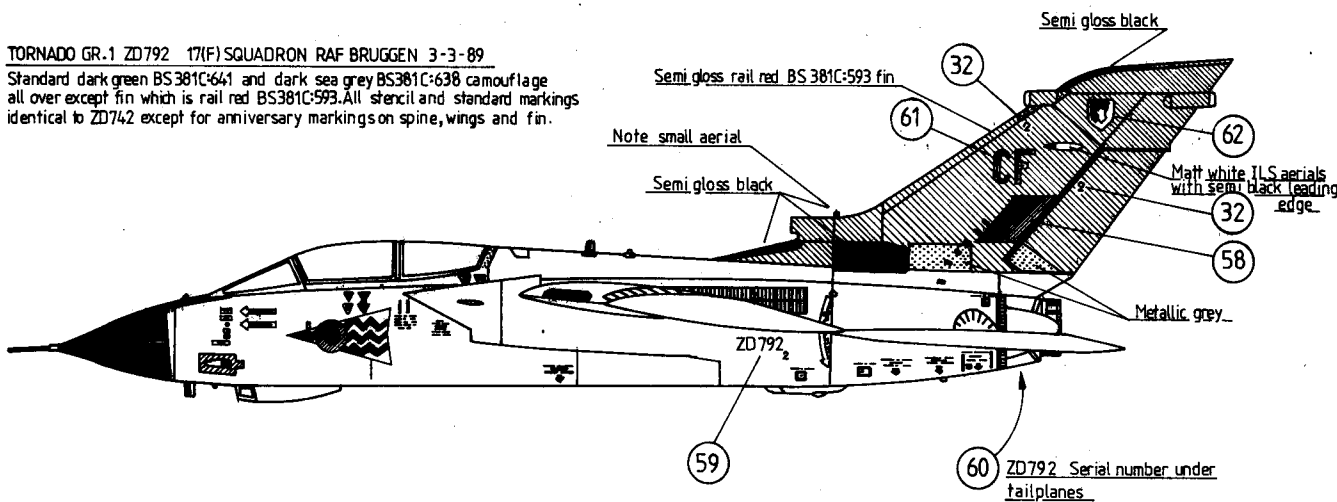


BOZ pod fits on starboard outer station underwing  
Sky Shadow pod fits on port outer station underwing



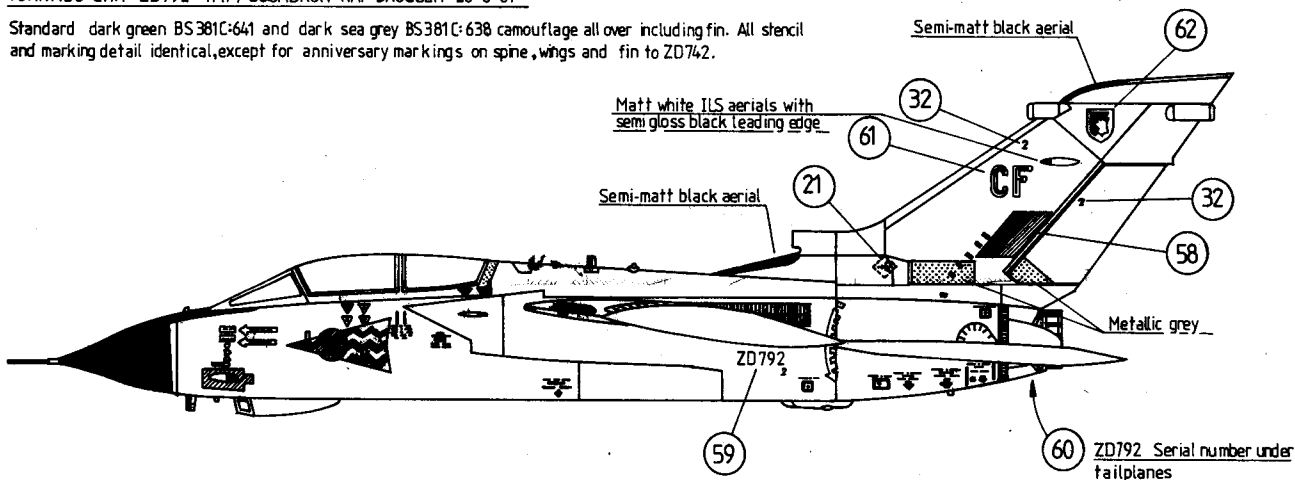
TORNADO GR.1 ZD792 17(F) SQUADRON RAF BRUGGEN 3-3-89

Standard dark green BS381C:641 and dark sea grey BS381C:638 camouflage all over except fin which is rail red BS381C:593. All stencil and standard markings identical to ZD742 except for anniversary markings on spine, wings and fin.

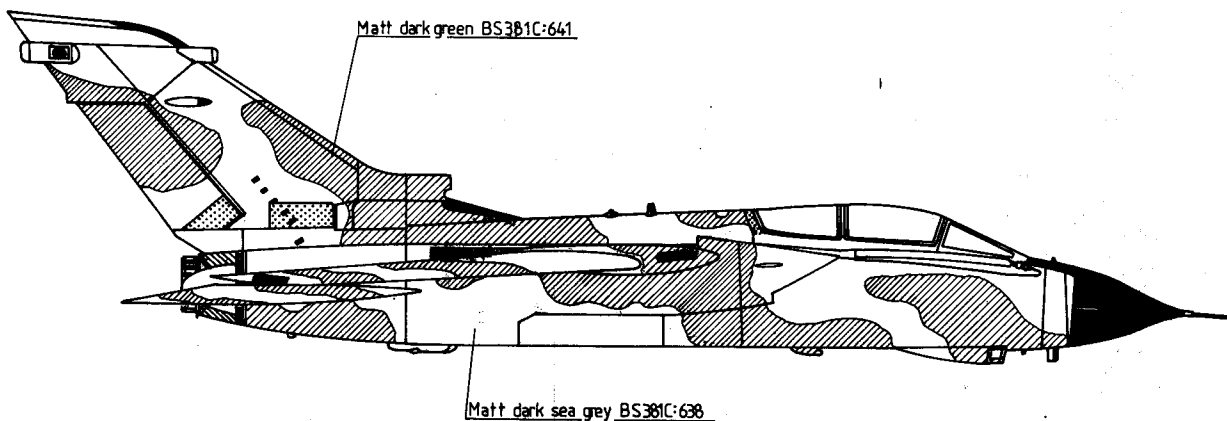


TORNADO GR.1 ZD792 17(F) SQUADRON RAF BRUGGEN 26-6-87

Standard dark green BS381C:641 and dark sea grey BS381C:638 camouflage all over including fin. All stencil and marking detail identical, except for anniversary markings on spine, wings and fin to ZD742.
